

Appendix B - Illness and Symptoms Guidelines for Staff and Students

## Illness and Symptom Requirements for Staff and Students

If you test positive for Covid or are exposed to someone with Covid the rules below <u>do not apply.</u> Any individual who tests positive for Covid-19 or who is exposed to someone with Covid-19 must stay home and contact their supervisor or principal. Administrators must immediately email Health Services at <u>CovidReport@scusd.edu</u>. Contact Tracers will provide guidelines for isolation/quarantine and return to school/work.



## STAY HOME IF YOU HAVE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- · Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- · Muscle or body aches
- Headache

- · New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Diarrhea
- Nausea or vomiting

## YOU MAY RETURN TO SCHOOL AFTER:

24 hours fever free and symptoms improved AND one of the following:

Presenting a negative Covid-19 test

or

Presenting a note from health care provider confirming symptoms are the result of another diagnosis

Of

10 DAYS have passed

**Chronic conditions:** Children with documented non-infectious chronic conditions can return to school when symptoms have improved. A doctor may diagnose an illness other than COVID-19 and provide a notefor return to school earlier than 10 days. Children with unmanaged Covid-like symptoms (such as congestion, coughing, runny nose) may be sent home until symptoms have improved. If there are questions about individual cases, contact your school nurse or health services.
