ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL CHANGES

We appreciate all your patience with the first day of school today. We were so excited to have our students on campus! We are aware that it was very congested this morning and we are revamping some procedures to help with some of the congestion at arrival and dismissal. Please note the following changes:

- Students who are NOT eating breakfast will enter through the gates in the main walkway. Please do not send students before 7:45 am if they are not eating. Adults will not be allowed past the front gate.
- Kindergarten students will line up at the cafeteria door closest to the parking lot. Only kindergarten students will line up at this door.
- All other students eating breakfast will line up at the cafeteria door closest to the office.
- It is extremely important that parents keep the walkway in front of the doors clear. I know you want to see your children, but it impedes the flow into the cafeteria.
- At dismissal, we are moving where kids line up and spreading them out in the grass in front of the school. The lines will be set back toward the school building so there is more room for parents to gather and locate their children in the grade level lines.
- Please remember that you may not double park and ask your child to get into the car. If you are going to park across the street, let your child know and s/he can use the crosswalk to meet you over there once they see you.
